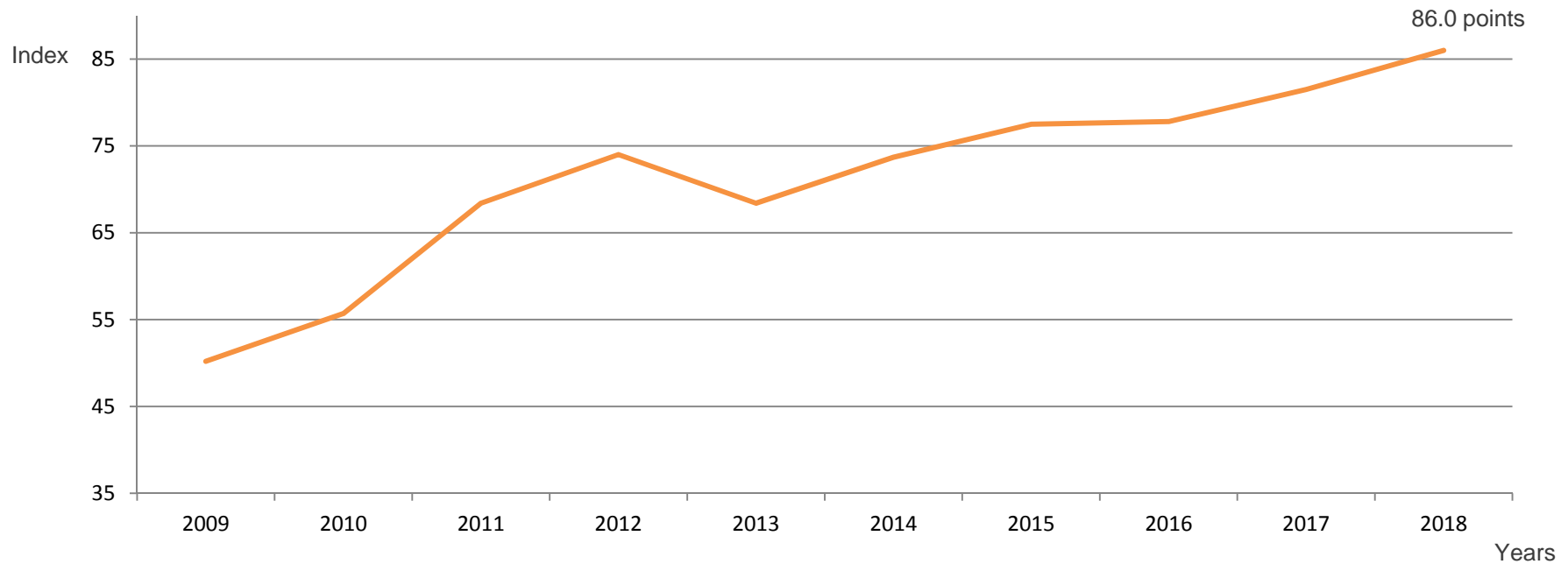

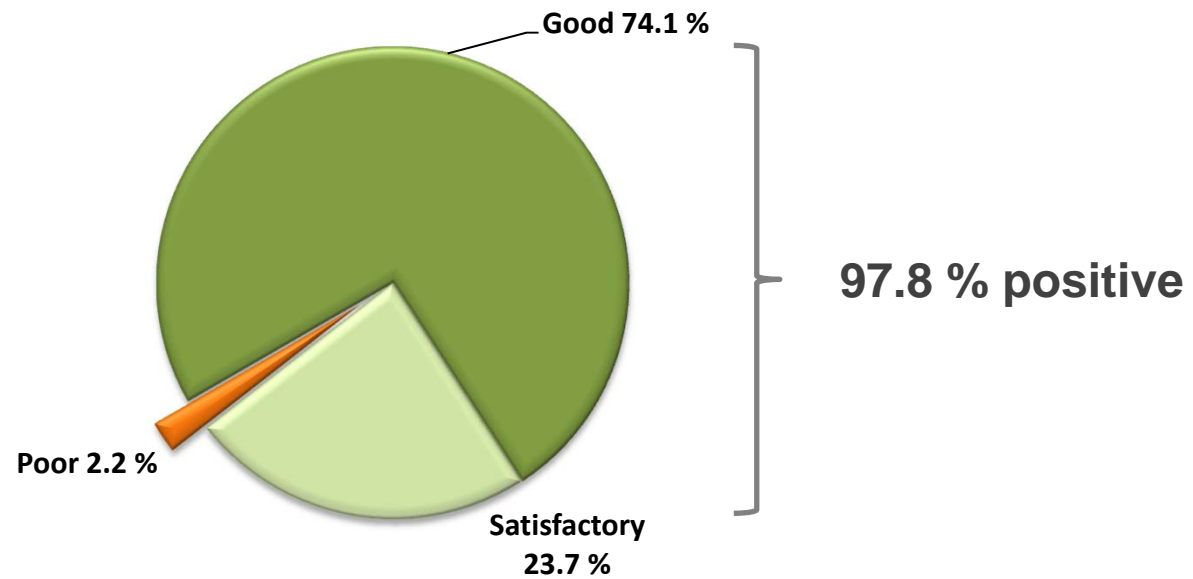

Business-climate index



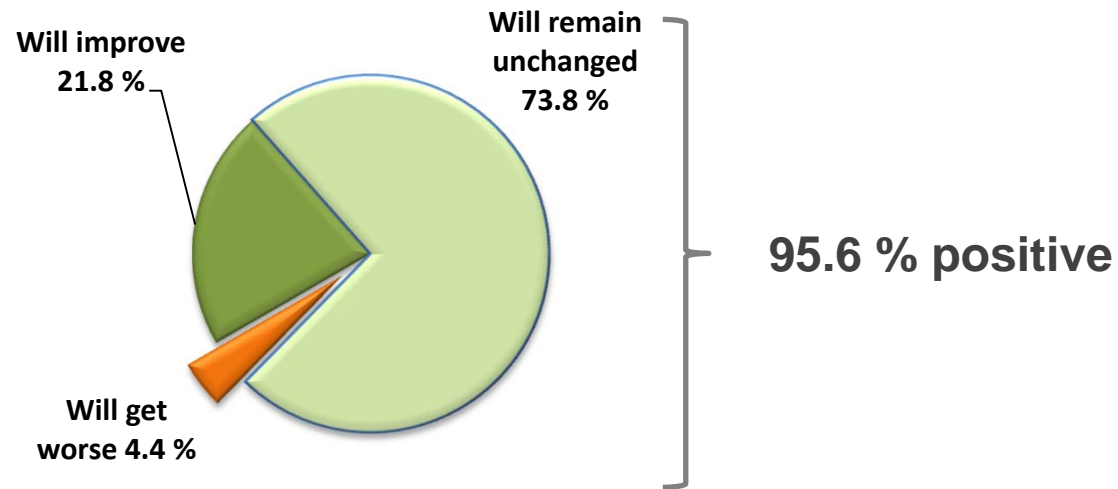

Current business situation



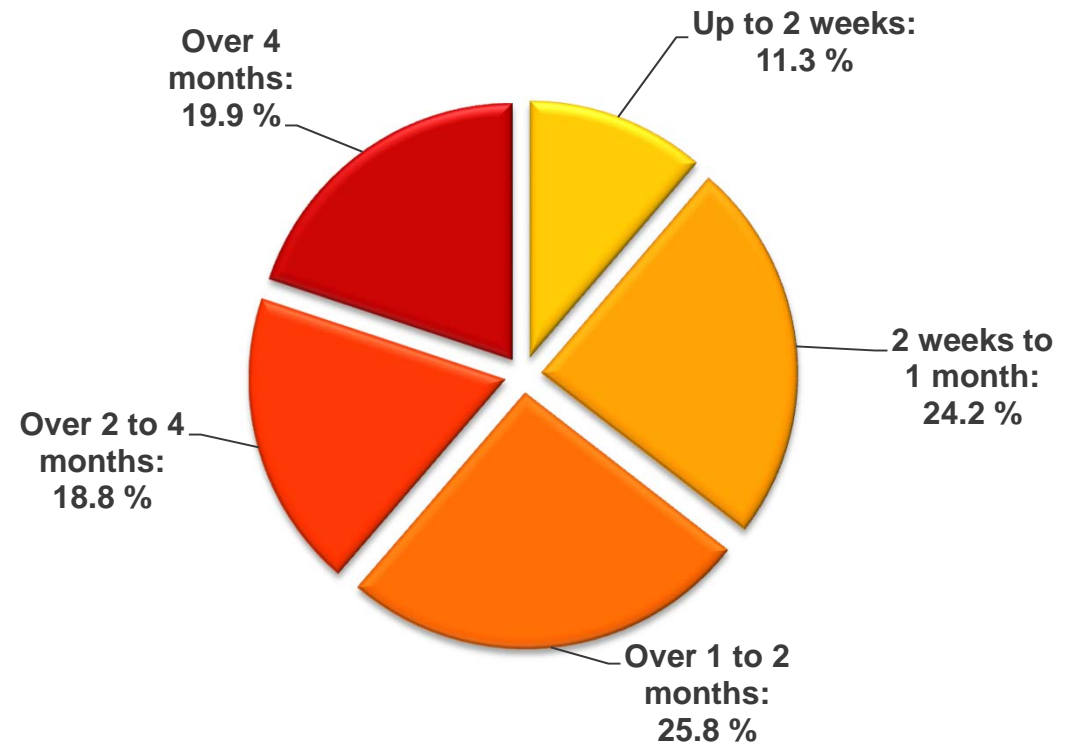

Future business situation



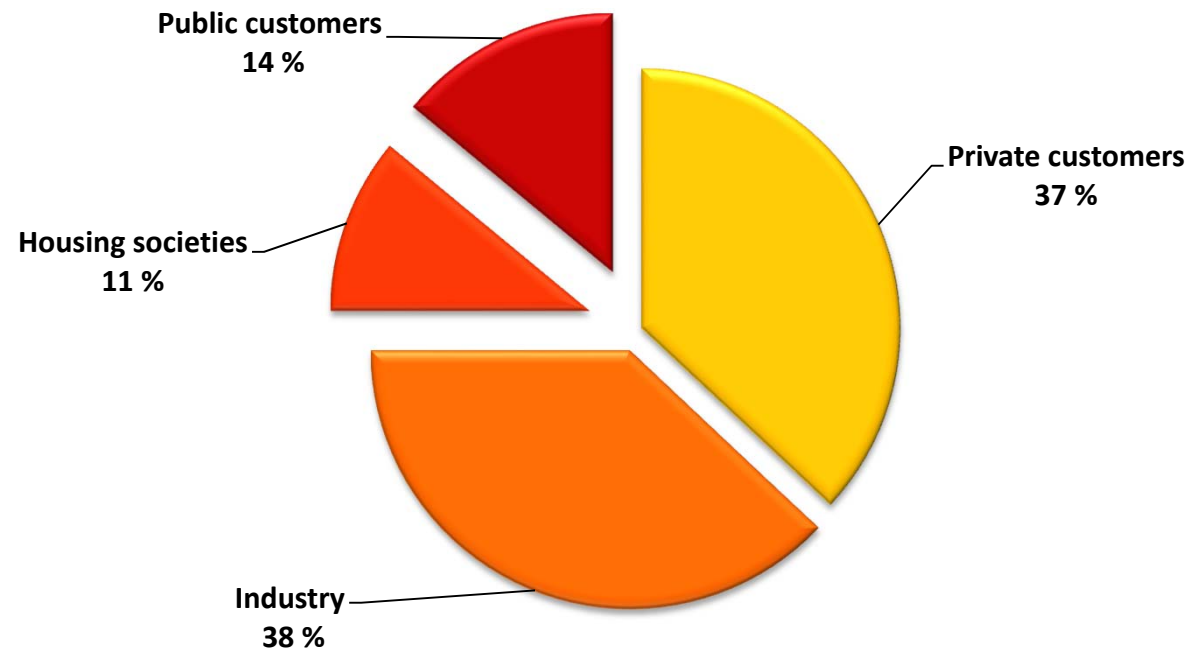

Orders in hand



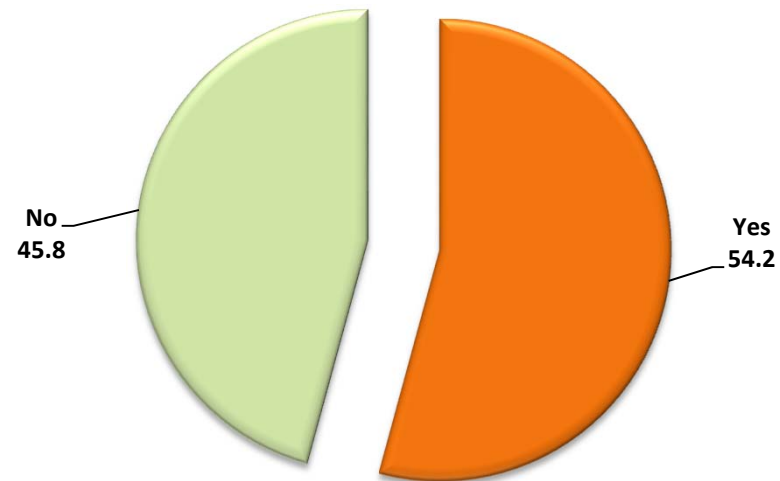
