Austrian architect and lighting designer Anna Tomschik was born in 1990.

She studied architecture at the University of Technology in Vienna and at Chalmers Tekniska Högskola in Gothenburg. In 2015 she received her master degree in Architecture. During her stay in Sweden, Anna developed a great interest in light. In order to strive her sensitivity within the field, she enrolled at the master programme Architectural Lighting Design at KTH Stockholm.

Topic of her master thesis was the development of a sun and moon inspired luminaire that invites to create one's own lighting rhythm. HENYX was titled "1st place - LAMP International Design Award" in Vancouver. Furthermore her design received the title „Emerging LIT Design Award Winner - Product Design of the Year 2017“ in Tokyo.

During her working experience at Light Bureau in London, Anna was named "40 under 40 - Lighting Design Talent 2017".

Currently she lives in Stockholm and works as architectural lighting designer specialized in daylight and man-made lighting.
