

Exhibition/Prize-giving ceremony

All winning designs or prototypes will go on display in a special show which will hold at Light + Building from 8 to 13 March 2020. All participants who have received "Best of" and "Special Mention" distinctions will be honoured with a certificate as part of a festive prize-giving ceremony held during Light + Building 2018. In addition, the winning products will be published in the form of postcards and included in the internationally oriented Light + Building press relations work.

Prize money

The award is an outstanding opportunity for up-and-coming designers to introduce themselves to the sector and network with manufacturing companies. Moreover, those designers who win a "Best of" award or "Special Mention" receive prize money totalling 5,000 euros. The jury is free to allocate the prize money as it sees fit.
