Please note the regulations to access the exhibition ground and follow the signs to "Check-In" from the motorway A648.

Access to the fairground by vehicles

Access to the fairground by vehicles is only possible with registration! Please register your vehicle in time (beginning 10 weeks prior to event) at: https://einfahrt.messefrankfurt.com/ees/deliverer

Check-In

During set-up and dismantling times access to the fairgrounds by vehicle is only possible through Check-In! Please follow the signs to "Check-In" from the motorway A648.

Access to the fairground during dismantling

On the last day of the event access to the fairground is limited:

- After 2 p.m. it is no longer possible to enter the fairground without a special entry permit. Exhibitor parking permits issued lose their validity at 2 p.m.
- From 3 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. it is only possible to enter to the fairground via Gate West with small vehicles up to 3,5 t maximum weight with a special entry permit. These special entry permits can be obtain from 25.09. − 02.10. daily between 10 a.m. − 2 p.m. at the Central Information Desk on Level 02 of the Torhaus by signing a declaration that you will be charged an additional €200.00 when invoiced for your ancillary costs if you do not leave the exhibition grounds with your vehicle by the deadline specified in the pass. Special dismantling vehicle passes will only be issued to exhibitors upon presentation of an exhibitor ID and customer number.
- If you leave the fairground until 5:30 p.m. only via Gate West, the special entry permit will be withdrawn and the exit will be confirmed.
- Between 4:30 p.m. 9 p.m. priority empties will be delivered to the booths.
- For following dismantling entries the online vehicle registration in advanced is not required:
 - From 6:30 p.m. access to the fairground is possible for vehicles up to 7,49 t maximum weight from the truck assembly point at the Rebstock area and must leave the fairground until 3 a.m. at the latest. You do not need a Check-In registration.
- From 8 a.m. on 03.10.2020 regular vehicle access for dismantling starts from the assembly point at the Rebstock area.
- 03.10.2020 05.10.2020: for the regular dismantling all vehicles have to be registered again in advanced: https://einfahrt.messefrankfurt.com/ees/deliverer.
 All vehicles are directed via the Rebstock Check-In.
- We recommend that you check with your haulage contractor whether you can apply for an exception to the ban on Sundays and public holidays in order to use the dismantling time efficiently
- We also recommend that you plan trips with your haulage contractor so that the full day is used for loading on dismantling Monday, October 5th, 2020. Please be at the check-in as early as possible, as we cannot rule out longer waiting times.
