

## Product and person data for the Light & Building PDF presentation

Burhan Bilcok is a German project developer and designer who realizes and projects of his own creations and drafts by external designers.

"At the Light & Building in Frankfurt a. M. I present a reading lamp or work table lamp with the type designation Q1.1 from the Collezione Obliquus series. The Latin name, obliquus in German diagonally or rather obliquely, resulted simply from this, because the lines of the designs are diagonal to the verticals delimiting the space."

The lamp will be presented to the international trade public for the first time at the Light & Building in Frankfurt a.M. It is a standard version of the model Q1.1. The concept for the entire lighting design objects of the Collezione Obliquus includes several finely differentiated versions for each model. The luminaire presented is an interaction result. With the obligation to produce, the rights of use for the exhibited and all other designs of the Collezione Obliquus can be acquired about a license agreement.

The dominant materials of the light object are:

Wood, metal (sheet metal or aluminum), iron parts, glass, cabel, switches, LED lights.
