cassini

is a lighting series that combines functional illumination with atmospheric presence. Each luminaire integrates two light sources: a direct, bright light for everyday use and a soft, indirect light that creates atmosphere. Formally, Cassini is inspired by topographic maps—layering and lines shape the body of the lamps and guide the light rather than simply emitting it. Made from birch and glass, the series draws on organic forms and colors of the 1970s.
